CHINA GEOLOGICAL SURVEY, THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

I. INTRODUCTION

1. Pursuant to the visit of the Thai Delegation to China during 12-17 June 2011 to attend the CGS-DMR executive meeting between the China Geological Survey (CGS), Ministry of Land and Resources, China, and the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR), Ministry of Natural Resource and Environment, Thailand. The CGS-DMR executive meeting was held on 17 June 2011 in Beijing.

2. The Chinese Delegation was led by Dr. LI Jinfa, Deputy Director General of CGS. The Thai Delegation was led by Mr. Adisak Thongkaimook, Director General of DMR.

3. The objectives of the meeting were to discuss on proposed project proposals and work plan in Year 2012.

II. RESULTS OF THE MEETING

1. Setting up of Technical Working Groups

Both sides agreed to set up technical working groups. The head and members of technical working group of each side shall be assigned. The working groups of both sides should meet at least once a year to discuss possible topics of cooperation, to develop project proposals, to review the cooperative status, to decide and organize the venue of joint seminar/meetings. The working groups will report to the executive group. Both sides will take turn to host the Working Group Meeting.

2. Consideration of Proposed CGS-DMR Cooperative Project Proposals:

The meeting considered drafts of two project proposals, which are:

- 1) The Development of Geopark in Thailand.
- 2) The Development of Geological Information System for Urban Planning: subsurface geological data for important cities in Thailand.

DMR will further communicate with responsible persons of CGS. The Final project proposals will be ready for evaluation and granting by end of October.

3. Conditions:

3.1 Both sides were aware that all agreed activities would be subjected to the respective plan and budget of their respective governments and available funding.

3.2 Both sides will finance their own expenses. Host countries may provide some assistance, c.g. logistic, vehicle, etc.

III. OTHER MATTERS

The meeting took note that the next CGS-DMR executive meeting will be held in Thailand in 2012.


